2 becoming the first black woman to be appointed chief deputy
3 constable in Travis County; and

4 WHEREAS, A lifelong resident of East Austin, Ms. Davis is an
5 alumnus of Northeast High School and a graduate of Concordia
6 University; she has served the Travis County Constable's Office for
7 more than two decades, having previously worked her way up from
8 court clerk to office manager before receiving her peace officer's
9 license in 2016; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Davis has dutifully fulfilled her
11 responsibilities as a reserve deputy for the past four years; she
12 was appointed to her new post as chief deputy constable by Tonya
13 Nixon, who became the first black woman to be elected to the office
14 of Travis County constable in November 2020; and

15 WHEREAS, The Travis County Constable's Office has benefited
16 greatly from Gwendolyn Davis's skill, professionalism, and deep
17 dedication to public service, and she may indeed reflect with pride
18 on her accomplishments as she takes on this exciting new role; now,

21 Legislature hereby congratulate Gwendolyn Davis on being appointed
22 chief deputy constable for Travis County and extend to her sincere
