6 22 charter members established the sorority at Howard University in

7 Washington, D.C., as a means of promoting academic excellence and

8 community service; that same year, the group took its first public

9 action, participating in a march for women's suffrage in the

10 nation's capital; and

11 WHEREAS, Residents of the Lone Star State have played a

12 prominent role in Delta Sigma Theta since the beginning; among the

13 sorority's founders were four women from Texas: Zephyr Chisom

14 Carter of El Paso, Jessie McGuire Dent of Galveston, Frederica

15 Chase Dodd of Dallas, and Myra Davis Hemmings of Gonzales; through

16 the years, a multitude of other Texans have joined the group's

17 membership, including such important figures as Texas State Senator

18 and U.S. Congresswoman Barbara Jordan and Texas State

19 Representative Ruth Jones McClendon; and

20 WHEREAS, Today, Delta Sigma Theta's strong presence in Texas

21 extends to 46 alumnae and 28 collegiate chapters; these groups

22 promote the sorority's "Five-Point Programmatic Thrust" by working

23 to further economic development, international awareness,

24 political involvement, physical and mental health, and educational
