5 1984, when he accepted a job as an administrative assistant; he went
6 on to lead the parks and recreation, public works, and municipal
7 services departments before becoming assistant city manager in
8 1998, and he was chosen as the new city manager in 2012; and

9 WHEREAS, During his time in Rockwall, Mr. Crowley has played
10 a vital role in its growth from a small town to a bustling city,
11 overseeing such important developments as the expansion of the
12 city's parks and recreation system, the creation of The Harbor
13 retail center, and the transition to a combined paid-volunteer fire
14 department; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Crowley previously worked for the municipal
16 government in Burleson and served as city manager for Colorado
17 City; and

18 WHEREAS, Rick Crowley's adept and forward-looking leadership
19 has helped guide Rockwall through a transformative period in its

21 resonate in the years to come; now, therefore, be it
