1 WHEREAS, Dr. Gene Getz has made a positive and lasting
2 difference in his community of faith during his longtime service in
3 the ministry; and

4 WHEREAS, In 1972, Dr. Getz began his involvement in church
5 planting and launched the Fellowship Bible Church movement, which
6 has led to the establishment of hundreds of congregations
7 throughout the nation, including several in the Dallas area; he
8 currently serves as president of the Center for Church Renewal, a
9 nonprofit organization he started in 1978, and he is pastor
10 emeritus of Chase Oaks Church in Plano; and

11 WHEREAS, Following his retirement from the pastorate,
12 Dr. Getz completed work on his interactive *Life Essentials Study*
13 *Bible*, which is used by people around the world and has also been
14 released in Spanish; furthermore, he produces *Bible Principles*, a
15 daily radio broadcast that airs on a number of stations, and he is
16 the author of more than 60 books, including *The Measure of a Man:*
17 *Twenty Attributes of a Godly Man*; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Getz graduated from Moody Bible Institute, and
19 he later taught there and at Dallas Theological Seminary; he holds a
20 master's degree from Wheaton College Graduate School and a Ph.D.
21 from New York University; and

22 WHEREAS, Dr. Gene Getz exemplifies the highest standards of
23 his vocation, and he has inspired innumerable Texans through his
24 message of faith and goodwill; now, therefore, be it
