1           WHEREAS, Family and friends were deeply saddened by the  
2 passing of Jerry Moon Mullins of Weatherford on October 25, 2019, at  
3 the age of 68; and

4           WHEREAS, The son of John and Margaret Mullins, Jerry Mullins  
5 was born in Rochester, Indiana, on January 13, 1951; he was raised  
6 by his father and his stepmother, Patricia Mullins, and he grew up  
7 with six siblings, Judy, Joyce, Steve, Terry, Deborah, and Cynthia;  
8 a 1969 graduate of Triton High School, he earned degrees in aviation  
9 electronics and business management from Purdue University; and

10           WHEREAS, Mr. Mullins embarked on his career in 1973 as a  
11 supervisor for Texas Instruments; he next secured a management  
12 position with General Dynamics in 1978, and he worked there until  
13 1993, when he was named president and CEO of Heli-Dyne Systems; in  
14 2004, he took on the roles of president and CEO for Enstrom  
15 Helicopter Corporation, and a decade later he became a consultant  
16 for KMI Fabricators, Inc., serving in that capacity through 2019;

18           WHEREAS, Above all, Mr. Mullins treasured time spent with his  
19 family; he shared a rewarding marriage of four and a half decades  
20 with his wife, the former Nancy Oldfield, and he was the devoted  
21 father of two sons, Matthew Mullins and the late Clinton Mullins;  
22 moreover, he took tremendous pride in his two grandchildren,  
23 Bryleigh and Braden; a problem solver by nature, he was admired for  
24 his building skills, and he enjoyed boating, operating remote

1 control helicopters, and playing golf, tennis, and basketball; a  
2 man of faith, he was a valued member of Trinity Bible Church in  
3 Willow Park; and

4 WHEREAS, Admired for his integrity, kindness, and  
5 generosity, Jerry Mullins lived a caring and purposeful life, and  
6 he will forever be a source of inspiration to those he leaves  
7 behind; now, therefore, be it

9 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Jerry Moon Mullins
