1 WHEREAS, The life of an esteemed educator drew to a close with
2 the passing of Julie Anna Choate of Hudson Oaks on August 15, 2020,
3 at the age of 50; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Fort Worth on July 2, 1970, the former Julie
5 Newbury was the daughter of Don and Brenda Newbury, and she grew up
6 with two sisters, Jana and Jeanie; she married Bryan Choate on June
7 11, 1994, and they shared a rewarding union that spanned 26 years
8 and became the proud parents of two children, Benjamin and Brittin;

10 WHEREAS, A graduate of Howard Payne University and Dallas
11 Baptist University, Mrs. Choate enjoyed a career as an educator for
12 more than 29 years; she began as a teacher at Deer Creek Elementary
13 School in the Crowley Independent School District and eventually
14 became an assistant principal in the district; she later joined the
15 faculty of Aledo ISD and spent more than a decade at McCall
16 Elementary School, where she served first as assistant principal
17 and then as principal; and

18 WHEREAS, In honor of Mrs. Choate's significant contributions
19 to her community, the Julie Choate Higher Education Fund has been
20 established for her son, who graduated from Aledo High School in
21 2019, and her daughter, who is a junior at Aledo High; Mrs. Choate
22 was a valued congregant of Trinity Bible Church, and she drew
23 strength from her deep and abiding faith throughout her life; and

24 WHEREAS, Julie Choate possessed a generosity of spirit that
