1 WHEREAS, A life made rich through meaningful service drew to
2 a close with the passing of Anne Newberry Bergman of Weatherford on
3 November 4, 2020, at the age of 95; and

4 WHEREAS, The former Anne Newberry was born in Weatherford on
5 March 12, 1925, to William and Mary Newberry; she received a
6 bachelor's degree in accounting from Trinity University in 1946,
7 and the following year, she married Robert Bergman, whom she had met
8 on a blind date; the couple shared a rewarding marriage that spanned
9 seven decades, and they took great pride in their three children,
10 Elizabeth, John, and William, and in their 11 grandchildren and 4
11 great-grandchildren; and

12 WHEREAS, Passionate about politics, Mrs. Bergman was a
13 delegate to the Republican Party state convention beginning in
14 1952, and she contributed her time and energy to a number of
15 gubernatorial, congressional, and presidential campaigns; from
16 1976 to 1977, she served as president of the Texas Federation of
17 Republican Women; engaged in her local community as well, she held a
18 city council seat and was a founding member of the Friends of the
19 Weatherford Public Library; she attended All Saints' Anglican
20 Church, and she played a key role in establishing the church's
21 orphanage in Mexico; and

22 WHEREAS, Above all else, Mrs. Bergman cherished time spent
23 with her family, and she especially enjoyed traveling and sailing;
24 she and her husband were also valued members of the Weatherford Wine

1 and Food Society; and

2 WHEREAS, While the passing of Anne Bergman brings great
3 sadness to her loved ones, she leaves behind a legacy that will long
4 be treasured by all those who held her dear; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
6 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Anne Newberry
7 Bergman and extend heartfelt sympathy to the members of her family:
8 to her daughter, Elizabeth Bozzell; to her sons, John Bergman and
9 his wife, Nancy, and William Bergman and his wife, Melissa; to her
10 grandchildren, Catherine, Carrie, Drew, Grant, Spencer, Brett,
11 Ellen, Anne, Randi, and Riley; to her great-grandchildren, Noah,
