3 the age of 74; and

15 for the last 37 years of his career, he was the chief appraiser for
16 the Parker County Appraisal District; actively engaged in his
17 community, he was a member of the Kiwanis Club and the Weatherford
18 Rotary Club; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. Hammonds shared a rewarding marriage with his
20 wife, Beverly Sue Hammonds, that spanned 53 years, and he took great
21 pride in their sons, Phil and Jeff; with the passing years, he had
22 the pleasure of seeing his family grow to include five
23 grandchildren, Ryan, Lauren, Taylor, Barrett, and Brenley; in his
24 leisure hours, he enjoyed fishing, hunting, gardening, and playing
