WHEREAS, A man of many talents, Mr. Dunn operated radio stations KSFA-AM and FM92 from 1959 to 1989, and he was a longtime sports announcer for Stephen F. Austin State University and Nacogdoches High School; passionate about flying, he produced air shows in Nacogdoches and the surrounding area for 40 years, and local residents could often see his yellow and navy PT-19 circling above the city; and

23 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Dunn enjoyed the love and 24 support of his wife, Nancy Raborn Dunn, with whom he shared a
