1 WHEREAS, A full and productive life drew to a close with the 2 passing of former state representative Robert Lewis Fairchild of 3 Center on December 1, 2019, at the age of 90; and WHEREAS, The son of Robert Carl Fairchild and Anna Dagma 4 5 Lewis Fairchild, Bob Fairchild was born in Beaumont on January 31, 1929, and grew up in Chester; he completed both his bachelor's 6 degree in business administration and his law degree at The 7 University of Texas at Austin; in 1953, he co-founded the Center law 8 9 firm known today as Fairchild, Price, Haley & Smith; he was admitted to practice before the U.S. Supreme Court and Fifth Circuit Court of 10 11 Appeals, among other venues; dedicated to his profession, he served 12 as president of the Shelby County Bar Association, and he was a member of the East Texas Chapter of the American Board of Trial 13 14 Advocates and a Fellow of the Texas Bar Foundation; in 1994, he retired from his practice, and nine years later, he was honored by 15 the State Bar for 50 years of service to the organization; and 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Fairchild served in the Texas House from 1961 to 17 18 1965; during his tenure, he chaired both the General Investigating and Judicial Districts Committees, and he was a member of a number 19 of other committees; he further benefited his fellow citizens as 20 21 president of the Shelby County Chamber of Commerce, and he helped organize Little League baseball in his community; a deacon of First 22 23 Baptist Church since 1979, he taught the Fellowship Class for many
