RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Texas game wardens have protected their fellow
- 2 citizens and the state's natural resources for 125 years; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In 1895, the 24th Texas Legislature established the
- 4 office of Fish and Oyster Commissioner to enforce laws related to
- 5 those industries; four years later, it gave the Fish and Oyster
- 6 Commission jurisdiction over all public waters, including
- 7 freshwater streams, lakes, and ponds, and it later added commercial
- 8 shrimping to the portfolio; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The agency underwent several name changes before
- 10 1963, when it became the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department; in
- 11 that era, wardens were first charged with promoting recreational
- 12 water safety; the legislature designated game wardens as Texas
- 13 peace officers in 1971, and eight years later, TPWD hired its first
- 14 female game warden; and
- WHEREAS, In the past decade, game wardens have formed
- 16 specialized teams to expand their capabilities; these include
- 17 underwater and swift-water recovery, forensic accident
- 18 reconstruction, and unmanned aerial surveillance; a K-9 unit was
- 19 launched in 2013, and game wardens have played a vital role in
- 20 rescue and recovery following such disasters as Hurricanes Ike and
- 21 Harvey; and
- WHEREAS, A force once small in size and scope, game wardens
- 23 now number more than 550, and they have been called "the Swiss Army
- 24 knife of Texas law enforcement"; many have aided the COVID-19

- 1 pandemic response, delivering personal protective equipment,
- 2 conveying samples to labs, and assisting at testing sites; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Over the course of more than a century, game wardens
- 4 have worked tirelessly to safeguard the state's natural resources
- 5 while taking on increasing responsibilities, and in so doing, they
- 6 have earned the lasting respect and appreciation of past, present,
- 7 and future generations of fellow Texans; now, therefore, be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 9 Legislature hereby honor Texas game wardens for 125 years of
- 10 service to the Lone Star State and extend to them sincere best
- 11 wishes for continued success in their endeavors; and, be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 13 prepared for Texas game wardens as an expression of high regard by
- 14 the Texas House of Representatives.
