R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, All who shared in the life of Jack W. Kohleffel of
2 Colorado County were deeply saddened by his passing on March 30,
3 2020, at the age of 72; and

4 WHEREAS, Jack Kohleffel was born to Leo and Doris Kohleffel
5 in Eagle Lake on September 25, 1947, and he grew up with the
6 companionship of two siblings, Bill and Janet; following his
7 graduation from Columbus High School, he attended Wharton County
8 Junior College and Southwest Texas State University; he later
9 enlisted in the U.S. Army and served at Fort Bliss in El Paso; and

10 WHEREAS, Upon returning to civilian life, Mr. Kohleffel
11 joined the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department; he completed his
12 training at the 30th Texas Game Warden Academy in 1973 and began his
13 career as a game warden in Coldspring before transferring to Edna,
14 where he continued to serve for 27 years until his retirement; and

15 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Kohleffel enjoyed the love
16 and support of his wife, Roxanne, with whom he shared a rewarding
17 union that spanned a half century; he took great pride in their
18 children, Michael, John, Monica, and Paul, and their nine
19 grandchildren, Ashley, Trent, Trey, Wes, Hunter, Clay, Jacob, Luke,
20 and Olivia; in his leisure hours, he took pleasure in gardening,
21 caring for his cows, and improving his land; and

22 WHEREAS, Jack Kohleffel treasured the time he spent in the
23 company of his family and friends, and those he leaves behind will
24 in turn cherish their memories of this kind and caring man; now,
