RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, On January 6, 2021, the United States of America
witnessed one of the most disturbing episodes in its history, when a
mob of thousands of rioters breached the U.S. Capitol and unleashed
violence, mayhem, and lawlessness at the seat of our nation's
government; and
WHEREAS, The chaotic events took place over several hours, as
insurrectionists pushed through barriers along the perimeter of the

7 insurrectionists pushed through barriers along the perimeter of the Capitol, overwhelmed Capitol Police officers, and chanted menacing 8 9 slogans, including terroristic threats against elected officials; those who perpetrated the attack, some of whom armed themselves 10 with tasers, tire irons, pepper spray, and makeshift weapons, did 11 12 so with the intent to disrupt the electoral process and the peaceful transition of executive power, a bedrock principle of American 13 14 democracy; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. Capitol Police are tasked with securing and 15 16 protecting the sacred halls of Congress and ensuring the safety of all legislators, staff, and visitors who occupy the Capitol 17 grounds; on January 6, Capitol Police officers found themselves 18 outnumbered against an increasingly hostile and violent throng of 19 20 extremists, who engaged in acts of vandalism and looting inside the Capitol and assaulted law enforcement personnel who stood in their 21 22 way; and

WHEREAS, Capitol Police officers valiantly risked their lives to repel rioters who were attempting to infiltrate the

- 1 chambers of Congress and do harm to the lawmakers who were sheltered
- 2 in place; around 140 officers were hurt during the attack and
- 3 several later lost their lives; Capitol Police officer Eugene
- 4 Goodman, who distracted and led rioters away from the Senate
- 5 chamber, was awarded the Congressional Gold Medal, the legislative
- 6 branch's most distinguished civilian honor, by a unanimous senate
- 7 vote; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Were it not for the courageous officers who stood
- 9 their ground on that day, the shocking events of January 6 could
- 10 have resulted in far greater destruction and loss of life, and they
- 11 are deserving of our highest praise for their heroism in service to
- 12 their country; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 14 Legislature hereby honor the law enforcement officers who defended
- 15 the United States Capitol during the January 6 insurrection and
- 16 extend sincere gratitude to the entire U.S. Capitol Police force as
- 17 it continues its vital work to safeguard the premises of our
- 18 nation's Capitol.
