3 WHEREAS, The son of Terry and Danna Taylor, Austin Taylor is 4 an officer for Rockwall High's FIRST Robotics Competition Team 1296 5 - Full Metal Jackets; he serves as a student ambassador and holds 6 certifications in OSHA and CPR procedures to fulfill official 7 duties at FIRST events; and
