3 Flag" for the Girl Scout Silver Award; and

6 people to take damaged flags for proper disposal; this notable
7 endeavor involved repurposing a stainless-steel box that was once
8 used for library book returns; after cleaning and repairing damages

10 design that features state and national symbols such as the Texas
11 and U.S. flags, an armadillo, and a bald eagle, as well as the image
12 of an American soldier; and
