1           WHEREAS, The Texas-produced film *You Are My Home* has won the  
2 hearts of viewers since its release on Netflix on December 4, 2020,

5           WHEREAS, Filmed in Harlingen, McAllen, and other cities in  
6 the Rio Grande Valley, this heartwarming Christmas movie tells the  
7 story of Alexandra, an American-born 11-year-old girl who ends up  
8 on the street when her mother, an undocumented immigrant, is  
9 deported by ICE; she is reluctantly taken in by Chloe, a recently  
10 widowed young woman, and the two come to care for each other, while  
11 the widow finds romance with a man named Carlos; and

12           WHEREAS, The production of the film contributed greatly to  
13 the economy and cultural vitality of the Rio Grande Valley, and it  
14 features a diverse cast of talented performers, including Eva Ariel  
15 Binder as Alexandra, Angel Parker as Chloe, Cristián de la Fuente as  
16 Carlos, and Alyssa Milano as Sloane, an immigration activist; the  
17 film was directed by Amanda Raymond from a screenplay by Marion  
18 Milner and Ms. Raymond; and

19           WHEREAS, This charming motion picture confronts the issue of  
20 immigration with humanity, empathy, and generosity, and it  
21 represents another impressive addition to the canon of fine filmed  
22 entertainment made in the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
