## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Proud supporters of energy independence are
- 2 celebrating Texas Energy Day at the State Capitol on March 24, 2021;
- 3 and
- WHEREAS, Texas is the number one state in the U.S. for oil and
- 5 natural gas production, refining capacity, and pipeline miles;
- 6 moreover, the state has played an important part in helping our
- 7 nation become the world's leader in oil and gas production, which
- 8 has created an unprecedented level of American energy security; the
- 9 oil and gas industry also contributes greatly to the economic
- 10 well-being of the state by providing high-paying jobs, and in 2020
- 11 it generated nearly \$14 billion in taxes and royalties that helped
- 12 fund such essential infrastructure as schools, roads, and emergency
- 13 services; and
- WHEREAS, In 2020, Texas school districts received more than
- 15 \$2 billion in property taxes from mineral properties producing oil
- 16 and natural gas, pipelines, and gas utilities, and Texas counties
- 17 received \$688.4 million; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The state's preeminent role in energy production has
- 19 been furthered through the use of fracking and other innovative
- 20 processes; many Texas oil and natural gas companies are leading the
- 21 way in developing new technologies designed to reduce water use,
- 22 expand water reuse, and increase the use of naturally occurring
- 23 salt water in their operations; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Because of advances in technology, carbon dioxide

- 1 emissions in the United States are at the lowest levels in nearly
- 2 three decades, and today, natural gas production has the smallest
- 3 carbon footprint compared to all other traditional fuel sources;
- 4 according to the Railroad Commission of Texas, the percentage of
- 5 natural gas flared out of all the natural gas produced in Texas
- 6 decreased by 67 percent between June 2019 and August 2020, with less
- 7 than one percent of the natural gas produced in Texas flared or
- 8 vented; further, even though oil and natural gas production have
- 9 skyrocketed, methane emissions from the industry are down 23
- 10 percent since 1990; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Oil and natural gas are used to make 96 percent of
- 12 products and materials that we use every day, including plastics,
- 13 medicines, computers, and more, and the Lone Star State is a vital
- 14 contributor to the nation's global energy leadership; now,
- 15 therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 17 Legislature hereby recognize March 24, 2021, as Texas Energy Day at
- 18 the State Capitol and extend to all those participating in the event
- 19 sincere best wishes for the future.
