WHEREAS, The Bazans served some five generations of Rio 15 16 Grande Valley residents at their Taco Ole Mexican Restaurants, where Ms. Bazan's enchiladas and Lenten capirotada were especially 17 popular; she could often be found happily working in the kitchen 18 alongside the cooks; she favored bright, stylish clothes, and at 19 20 the age of 70, she could be spotted driving around in a powder-blue 21 convertible, attired like a movie star in huge sunglasses and a flowy scarf, with grandchildren in the back seat; warm and caring, 22 23 she loved spending time with her large extended family, and she was a maternal presence in the lives of many others as well; she was 24
