14 WHEREAS, After spending two years at the nation's capital, Mr. Benton worked for a decade for District Photo Inc.; he then 15 returned to Georgia, going on to own and operate three print 16 companies; he and his family subsequently relocated to Dallas, 17 where he opened the Dreamhouse Furniture and Interior store and 18 operated it until his retirement; in addition to contributing to 19 his community as a business leader, he was an active Democratic 20 Party chair in Carrollton, and during elections, he could always be 21 found outside the Josey Ranch Library polling location encouraging 22 23 people to vote; and
