R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, In response to the widespread damage caused by
2 Winter Storm Uri, the Mexican American Bar Association of Dallas
3 hosted the Dallas Property Insurance Clinic on March 13 and 14,
4 2021; and

5 WHEREAS, Sponsored by MABA-Dallas, State Representative
6 Jessica González, and State Representative Ana-Maria Ramos, the
7 property insurance clinic provided free legal assistance to
8 community members that sustained damage to their homes or
9 businesses due to the storm; during the event, attorneys and
10 community advocates volunteered their time and talents to guide
11 area residents through the process of filing insurance claims; and

12 WHEREAS, MABA-Dallas strives to support and promote the
13 Latinx community through advocacy and professional development;
14 among its many initiatives, the organization offers opportunities
15 for continuing legal education and facilitates member
16 participation in pro bono legal services; moreover, it encourages
17 members of the Latinx community to pursue legal professions, and it
18 recognizes the outstanding work of Latinx attorneys and judges; and
