2 High School, has distinguished herself through her athletic and
3 academic achievements; and

4 WHEREAS, An outstanding multisport athlete, Ms. Hawkins
5 plays for the Lady Picker basketball, volleyball, and softball
6 teams; she also excels in the classroom, maintaining a grade point
7 average of more than 93 and is a 2020-2021 Academic All-State
8 honoree; and

9 WHEREAS, While she makes important contributions in each of
10 the sports she plays, she has won widespread acclaim for her skills
11 on the basketball court; she was named Most Valuable Player for
12 District 31-4A after helping her team win the school's first league
13 championship in 2021; benefiting from her leadership, the Lady
14 Pickers qualified for the playoffs for the third consecutive season
15 and recorded their first postseason victories; she turned in
16 exceptional performances in each of the team's four playoff
17 contests, as Robstown advanced all the way to the regional
18 semifinals; and

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Hawkins is the Lady Pickers' career scoring
20 leader with 1,649 points and was named to the 2020-2021 Texas
21 Association of Basketball Coaches 4A All-Region Team; moreover, she
22 has earned All-State, All-South Texas, and All-District
23 recognition over the course of her four-year career, and she was the
24 district and All-South Texas Newcomer of the Year as a freshman; and

2 unwavering commitment to excellence, Kiara Hawkins is a source of
3 pride for her school and community, and she is poised for further
4 success in the years ahead; now, therefore, be it
