RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, People of Asian descent have been an integral part
- 2 of Texas' culture and history for more than 150 years; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Texas is home to 1.5 million Asian Americans and
- 4 Pacific Islanders, and there are more than 150,000 Asian
- 5 American-owned businesses across the state that generate \$64
- 6 million in annual revenue; over 100,000 Texas health care workers
- 7 of Asian descent are serving on the frontlines in the battle against
- 8 the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Escalating anti-Asian rhetoric has resulted in
- 10 Asian Americans being attacked and scapegoated for the COVID-19
- 11 pandemic and has encouraged vandals to target Asian American
- 12 businesses and institutions; in San Antonio, a Vietnamese
- 13 American-owned noodle shop was vandalized with racist graffiti; in
- 14 Austin, a Buddhist temple was desecrated by an intruder; and
- WHEREAS, Anti-Asian American hate crimes increased by almost
- 16 150 percent over the previous year in America's most populous
- 17 cities, and there have been more than 2,800 reported hate incidents
- 18 against Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders from the start of the
- 19 pandemic; in San Angelo, a Korean student was assaulted after
- 20 standing up for himself to a racist neighbor; in Midland, a Burmese
- 21 family of three, including children ages two and six, were
- 22 assaulted and stabbed while shopping for groceries; eight people,
- 23 including six Asian American women, who were murdered in day spas in
- 24 the Atlanta, Georgia, area are the most recent casualties of

- 1 anti-Asian bigotry in the United States; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Hateful rhetoric and violence against Asian
- 3 Americans has increased since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic,
- 4 and there is much work to be done to ensure their safety and
- 5 well-being; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 7 Legislature hereby strongly condemn and denounce anti-Asian
- 8 bigotry, racism, and all hateful speech and violent action related
- 9 to COVID-19; and, be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge federal,
- 11 state, and local law enforcement officials to investigate and
- 12 document all credible reports of hate crimes, incidents, and
- 13 threats against the Asian American community in Texas.
