1 WHEREAS, James Allan Curry is retiring from Baylor University 2 following the spring 2021 semester, concluding a noteworthy career spanning 47 years in the department of political science; and 3 WHEREAS, A member of the Baylor faculty since 1974, James 4 5 Curry has been the Bob Bullock Professor of Public Policy and Administration for more than two decades; in 2001, he established 6 7 the Bob Bullock Scholars Program, which allows students to gain work experience at the State Capitol; he serves as director of both 8 9 that initiative and the Baylor Washington Internship Program, and he is the founder and director of the criminal justice minor; he 10 previously chaired the department of political science for 14 11 12 years, and his kindness and concern for others fostered an enduring climate of collegiality; dedicated to his profession, he has served 13 14 his discipline and the wider university community in numerous other leadership roles as well; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Dr. Curry is the coauthor of Constitutional Government: The American Experience, now in its 10th 17 edition; he has also published many peer-reviewed articles and book 18 chapters, and he has been much in demand as a speaker 19 professional conferences and as a news analyst; among myriad 20 21 accolades, he has received a Baylor Outstanding Tenured Faculty Award, and he has been recognized multiple times by Phi Beta Kappa 22 23 and Mortar Board for excellence in teaching; and

- 11 earned him the deep respect and admiration of all who are fortunate
