16 Holechek, and the couple went on to share a rewarding union that
17 spanned four decades; Mr. Barr took great pride in his two
18 children, Matthew and Amanda, and he was delighted to become "Bop"
19 to his four grandchildren, Cooper, Kinsey, Nathan, and Olivia; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Barr was a valued congregant of Lakepointe
21 Church in Rockwall; in his leisure time, he liked trying new
22 restaurants, and he also enjoyed sports, reading, and history; and
