1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Kosse are gathering on June 11
2 and 12, 2021, to mark the 150th anniversary of their community at a
3 celebration hosted by the City of Kosse and the Kosse Community
4 Center; and

5 WHEREAS, In conjunction with an annual homecoming weekend,
6 local entities are planning a host of activities to commemorate the
7 town's sesquicentennial; festivities include a barbecue cook-off,
8 a 5K run, a parade, and a street dance; the Kosse Heritage Society
9 will offer tours, and the public is invited to attend an open house
10 at the new Kosse City Hall and Municipal Court Building; and

11 WHEREAS, The history of Kosse dates back to the 1840s when
12 settlers made their homes near Duck Creek and ran a stage stop for
13 the Franklin-Springfield and Waco-Marlin stagecoach routes; in
14 1869, the completion of the Houston and Texas Central Railway
15 brought new businesses and a post office to the area, and in 1871,
16 the town was officially incorporated; and

17 WHEREAS, Today, the economy is supported by the Luminant
18 Kosse Mine, agriculture, ranching, and local businesses; residents
19 and visitors alike enjoy the peaceful atmosphere, and nearby Lake
20 Limestone and Fort Parker State Park are popular destinations for
21 fishing, boating, and camping; and

22 WHEREAS, Citizens of Kosse are dedicated stewards of their
23 rich heritage while they work to build an even brighter future, and
24 this special anniversary provides a fitting opportunity to
