WHEREAS, Today, the economy is supported by the Luminant Kosse Mine, agriculture, ranching, and local businesses; residents and visitors alike enjoy the peaceful atmosphere, and nearby Lake Limestone and Fort Parker State Park are popular destinations for fishing, boating, and camping; and
