16 Patsy, that spanned 35 years; he took great pride in his daughters,
17 Debra, Brenda, and Beverly, and his stepdaughter, Tammy, and he was

19 and two great-great-grandchildren; he especially delighted in the
20 time he spent with his family at their cabin in Laguna Park,

23 respected law enforcement professional, Jerry Noles lived a caring
24 and purposeful life, and he will forever be remembered with deep
