2 memories of George Reid Simmons of Waxahachie, who died on January
3 5, 2021, at the age of 74; and

4 WHEREAS, George Simmons was born in Roby on February 19,
5 1946, to Jeff and Alice Simmons, and he grew up with five siblings,
6 Len, Bobby Nell, Tom, Virginia, and Ben; he shared a loving

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Simmons was feisty, funny, and affectionate,
19 and he delighted in sharing stories and jokes with his loved ones;
20 he also enjoyed the time he spent fishing and working with
21 motorcycles and hot rods; and

22 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, a proud veteran, and a true and
23 loyal friend, George Simmons will be deeply missed, and those who
24 held him dear will always remember the generosity and love he
