RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, May 2021 has been set aside as Asian American and
- 2 Pacific Islander Heritage Month to recognize the accomplishments
- 3 and wide-ranging contributions of individuals who trace their
- 4 ancestry to Asia and the Pacific Islands; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Originally established by the United States
- 6 Congress as Asian-Pacific American Heritage Week, the observance
- 7 celebrates the diverse culture, traditions, and history of people
- 8 from the Asian continent and the islands of Melanesia, Micronesia,
- 9 and Polynesia in the Pacific; it was officially expanded into a
- 10 monthlong celebration in 1992; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The month of May was chosen for this commemorative
- 12 period because of two key events in our nation's history; on May 7,
- 13 1843, the first Japanese immigrants arrived, and on May 10, 1869, a
- 14 workforce largely composed of Chinese laborers completed the
- 15 Transcontinental Railroad; and
- WHEREAS, According to a 2017 U.S. Census Bureau estimate,
- 17 Asian Americans represent approximately 5 percent of the country's
- 18 population, while about 1.5 million Americans trace their origins
- 19 to Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands; among U.S.
- 20 states, Texas has the third-largest Asian American population and
- 21 the fourth-largest Pacific Islander population; and
- WHEREAS, In 2017, the Pew Research Center released a factual
- 23 analysis highlighting the growth and progress of the Asian American
- 24 community; the study established Asian Americans as the

- 1 fastest-growing of all the major racial or ethnic groups in the
- 2 United States in recent years, with a population increase of 72
- 3 percent between 2000 and 2015; the Pew analysis further noted that
- 4 the Asian American population as a whole had higher than average
- 5 levels of economic well-being and that more than half of Asian
- 6 Americans age 25 and older held at least a bachelor's degree; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Lone Star State is home to generations of
- 8 Americans who take great pride in their family roots in Asia and the
- 9 Pacific Islands, and this annual observance provides a welcome
- 10 opportunity to celebrate their significant contributions to the
- 11 prosperity and cultural vibrancy of our nation; now, therefore, be
- 12 it

- 14 Legislature hereby recognize May 2021 as Asian American and Pacific
- 15 Islander Heritage Month.
