3 Fitzpatrick on August 29, 2020, at the age of 63; and

7 earn a bachelor's degree in computer science from Texas A&M

10 Communications before becoming a paramedic in 1994; a year later,
11 he began volunteering with Potter County Fire & Rescue, and in 1999
12 he became a full-time firefighter with the department; a leader in

14 Academy, and he worked with Amarillo Emergency Services for more
15 than two decades; and

16 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, he benefited from the love and
17 support of his wife, Marsha, and he took great pride in his
18 daughter, Kim; through the years, he had the pleasure of seeing his
19 family grow to include two granddaughters, Lisa and Ali, and a
20 great-granddaughter, Taylor; in his leisure time, he enjoyed
21 reading, bowling, and watching Professional Bull Riders; and

22 WHEREAS, A devoted family man and a dedicated public servant,
23 Pat Fitzpatrick gave freely of his time and expertise to better his
24 community, and he leaves behind a record of service that his loved
