## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Lavergne Schwender is retiring as executive 2 director of the Greater Harris County 9-1-1 Emergency Network in 3 May 2021, drawing to a close an exemplary tenure with the network 4 that has spanned nearly four decades; and

5 WHEREAS, The Greater Harris County 9-1-1 Emergency Network is the largest 9-1-1 system in Texas and the second largest in the 6 United States, serving 48 cities in Harris and Fort Bend Counties; 7 in the early 1980s, Lavergne Schwender joined the network as its 8 legal counsel, and since May 2005, she has been its executive 9 director, responsible for administering its overall operations as 10 11 well as guiding the network through the rapid changes in telecommunications technologies over the past 16 years; under her 12 leadership, the network received the Outstanding 9-1-1 Program 13 14 Award from the NG9-1-1 Institute in 2011; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Schwender has long been a state pioneer in 9-1-1 16 services; in 1983, she supported legislation that created the Harris County system, which was the model for subsequent 9-1-1 17 districts, and she has played an equally important role in 18 additional 9-1-1 legislation and amendments, including the passage 19 of the statewide 9-1-1 wireless fee and the creation of tariffs that 20 21 have helped fund other 9-1-1 systems across the state; she also helped establish the Texas 9-1-1 Alliance; and 22

23 WHEREAS, A native of Houston, Ms. Schwender has been a 24 Dominican nun since 1963; she taught at several Catholic schools

1 while earning a master's degree in business administration at The 2 University of Texas, and she went on to receive a law degree from 3 the University of Houston; she was an attorney for 21 years with the 4 Harris County Attorney's Office, where she first became involved 5 with 9-1-1 legislation; and

6 WHEREAS, Lavergne Schwender's dedication, expertise, and 7 long-term commitment to the mission of the 9-1-1 system have 8 greatly benefited her fellow Texans and earned her the respect and 9 admiration of her peers, and she may indeed reflect with pride on a 10 career well spent as she embarks on the next exciting chapter of her 11 life; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas 13 Legislature hereby congratulate Lavergne Schwender on her 14 retirement from the Greater Harris County 9-1-1 Emergency Network 15 and extend to her sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be 16 it further

17 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 18 prepared for Ms. Schwender as an expression of high regard by the 19 Texas House of Representatives.
