6 served as assistant choir director at McNeil High; she went on to
7 establish a choir program at Walsh Middle School in 2008 and has
8 since served as its head choir director; under her leadership, the
9 Walsh Middle choirs have consistently earned sweepstakes ratings in
10 UIL competitions; and

11 WHEREAS, Prior to her tenure at Round Rock ISD, Ms. Moser-Ja
12 directed school choirs in the Fort Worth and Arlington areas; a
13 graduate of Evangel University, she holds a bachelor's degree in
14 music education; she is a member of several professional
15 organizations, including the Texas Music Educators Association,
16 the Texas Choral Directors Association, and the Texas Music
17 Adjudicators Association, and she serves as a clinician for the
18 Round Rock ISD Elementary Choral Festival and the TMEA All-Region
19 Treble Choir for Region 10; in all her endeavors, she enjoys the
20 love and support of her daughters, Makena and Sadie; and

21 WHEREAS, Through her exceptional ability to educate and
22 inspire, Cindy Moser-Ja has made a positive difference in the lives
23 of countless young Texans, and she may indeed reflect with pride on
24 a career well spent; now, therefore, be it
