2 better the lives of animals and humans alike in Houston's Greater
3 East End community; and

4 WHEREAS, In 2010, Barrio Dogs was founded with the mission of
5 raising awareness about proper pet care and the importance of
6 spaying and neutering; the organization focuses on the reasons
7 homeless animals exist and teaches residents about how animal birth
8 control and humane pet treatment and care can contribute to the
9 health, safety, and prosperity of their neighborhood and community;
10 while not a rescue group, the organization has also worked to find
11 loving homes for many stray dogs and cats; and

12 WHEREAS, Over the past year, the COVID-19 pandemic has
13 brought financial hardships to numerous local families, resulting
14 in Barrio Dogs receiving an increased number of requests for
15 assistance; during this challenging time, the organization has been
16 able to help a number of people pay for surgeries, annual checkups,
17 and other veterinary services that were beyond their means to
18 afford; and
