11 well as the Stephen F. Austin State University Symphony Orchestra,
12 Wind Ensemble, Wind Symphony, combined choirs, and opera workshop;
13 in addition, she has partnered with many composers to premiere new
14 works; and

16 for a number of churches in East Texas, and she has been involved in
17 music education through the Stephen F. Austin Music Preparatory
18 Division; skilled on the harp as well, she won first place in the
19 Symphony of Southeast Texas Concerto Competition and in the Mildred
20 Milligan Scholarship Competition of the American Harp Society
21 Greater Houston Chapter; her interest in musicology led to a Summer
22 Undergraduate Research Fellowship at LU to explore the intersection
23 between historically informed performance practice and modern
24 piano pedagogy; and
