R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Family and friends were deeply saddened by the
2 passing of Roger Harold Walter Haug of Lockhart on December 25,
3 2019, at the age of 76; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on October 19, 1943, in Seguin, Roger Haug was
5 the son of Otto and Otilia Haug; he grew up with two older
6 brothers, Otto and Lawrence, and graduated from Seguin High School
7 in 1961; answering his nation's call to duty, he enlisted in the
8 U.S. Air Force and served as a ground power mechanic at duty
9 stations in El Paso and on the island of Formosa; and

10 WHEREAS, Upon returning to Seguin, Mr. Haug took a job at the
11 Guadalupe Valley Electrical Cooperative; he went on to realize his
12 childhood dream of becoming a state game warden with the Texas Parks
13 and Wildlife Department, and he attended Texas A&M University for
14 his law enforcement and wildlife training; commissioned in February
15 1968, he spent a year in Victoria before transferring to Caldwell
16 County, where he served until his retirement on October 31, 1993; he
17 then pursued another long-held dream and worked as a cattle rancher
18 for several years before selling his business in 2000; in his
19 leisure time, he enjoyed fishing, gardening, and traveling,
20 especially to Alaska and the Panama Canal; and

21 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Haug enjoyed the love and
22 support of his wife, the former Beverly Jean Haecker, with whom he
23 shared five decades of marriage; he took great pride in their two
24 children, Laurie and Travis, and seven grandchildren; and

1 WHEREAS, Although Roger Haug is deeply missed, he has left
2 his family and friends with a wealth of memories that they will
3 forever treasure; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Roger Harold Walter
6 Haug and extend sincere condolences to the members of his family: to
7 his wife, Beverly; to his daughter, Laurie, and her husband,
