13 young athletes to reach their full potential; and

14 WHEREAS, A graduate of Texas State University, Mr. Morales  
15 holds two master's degrees from Sul Ross State University, one in  
16 counseling and the other in mid management principalship; and

19 supportive educational environment for students, and he may indeed  
20 reflect with pride on his exceptional record of achievement; now,
