1 WHEREAS, Senior Officer David Gonzalez retired from the
2 Corpus Christi Police Department on January 29, 2021, drawing to a
3 close an outstanding career in law enforcement that spanned 35
4 years; and

5 WHEREAS, A veteran of the U.S. Coast Guard, David Gonzalez
6 was hired by the Corpus Christi Police Department in August 1985;
7 after attending the police academy and completing his field
8 training, he was assigned to the patrol division; through the
9 years, he served the department in numerous capacities, including
10 as a field training officer, as a member of the department's SWAT
11 team, and as an investigator in the narcotics and vice division; he
12 also served on joint task forces with the DEA and FBI and with the
13 U.S. Secret Service Dignitary Protection Detail; he retired as an
14 investigator with the organized crime unit; and

15 WHEREAS, Officer Gonzalez has been the recipient of numerous
16 honors over the course of his tenure; in addition to receiving a
17 departmental commendation for his contributions to the Internet
18 Crimes Against Children program, he has been recognized by the DEA,
19 FBI, U.S. Secret Service, and U.S. Attorney's Office for the
20 Southern District of Texas; and

21 WHEREAS, Through his skill, professionalism, and deep
22 commitment to public safety, David Gonzalez has earned the lasting
23 respect of his colleagues and fellow citizens alike, and he may
24 indeed reflect with pride on his contributions; now, therefore, be
