1 WHEREAS, All who shared in the life of Roanoke City Council
2 member Steven Mel Heath were deeply saddened by his passing on
3 August 27, 2020, at the age of 63; and

4 WHEREAS, Steve Heath was born to Melvin and Nancy Heath in
5 Torrance, California, on May 16, 1957; he graduated from Mena High
6 School and went on to attend the University of Arkansas at
7 Fayetteville; and

8 WHEREAS, A charter member of the Roanoke Economic and
9 Industrial Development Corporation and a longtime member of the
10 Roanoke City Council, Mr. Heath dedicated more than two decades to
11 making Roanoke an even better place in which to live and work; he
12 was first elected to the city council in 1997, and he played a vital
13 role in numerous initiatives, including improvements to the city's
14 water and sewer infrastructure, extensive economic development,
15 and the implementation of a Master Trail Plan to increase
16 walkability throughout the city; moreover, he was instrumental in
17 the construction of several city facilities, such as a law
18 enforcement center, fire station, and recreation center, as well as
19 renovations to the library and community center; in addition to his
20 civic endeavors, he was the owner of a successful business, Heath
21 Logistics, Inc.; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Heath was preceded in death by his first wife,
23 Krista, and his infant daughter, Rachel; he shared a rewarding
24 marriage with his second wife, Gayla, and he took great pride in his

1 sons, Tyler and Jeremy; he also delighted in time spent with his
2 grandchildren, Tyler and Madeline, and his niece and nephew,
3 Cassandra and Bryar; and

4 WHEREAS, Steve Heath lived a rich and purposeful life
5 centered around his family and his community, and he leaves behind a
6 record of service that his loved ones can remember with pride; now,
7 therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
9 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Steven Mel Heath and
10 extend sincere condolences to all who mourn his passing; and, be it
