RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Tolar High School band has been invited by the 2 mayor of Honolulu, Hawaii, to represent the State of Texas at 3 remembrance day ceremonies on the 80th anniversary of Pearl Harbor 4 on December 7, 2021; and

5 WHEREAS, On that day in 1941, the Japanese military launched 6 a devastating surprise attack on the United States Pacific Fleet at 7 Pearl Harbor, sinking or damaging eight battleships and killing 8 more than 2,400 Americans; called "a date which will live in infamy" 9 by President Franklin Roosevelt, the attack resulted in the entry 10 of the United States into World War II, which ended with the 11 surrender of Japan in September 1945; and

WHEREAS, The 80th anniversary of this historic event is being marked on National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day and will include a series of commemorative concerts from December 4 through 8, 2021; the only high school band from Texas to be invited, the Tolar Rattler Band will take part in an official military wreath-laying ceremony at the USS *Arizona* Memorial and an official flag-folding teremony at the USS *Missouri* Memorial; and

WHEREAS, In recent years, the Tolar High band has achieved notable success; in 2015 and 2017, the band advanced to the finals of the University Interscholastic League 2A State Marching Contest, and it made the area round of marching in 2019; the band has also earned sweepstakes awards each year from 2015 to 2019, and many of its members have made the area round of all-region and received

superior ratings as solo performers or as part of ensembles; and WHEREAS, The Tolar High School band's invitation to perform at the 80th anniversary commemoration of Pearl Harbor represents a considerable achievement by these skilled and dedicated young musicians, and it is a pleasure to join in recognizing their participation in this milestone event; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas 8 Legislature hereby commend the Tolar High School band on its 9 invitation to participate in the Pearl Harbor 80th anniversary 10 commemoration ceremonies and extend to its members sincere best 11 wishes for continued success; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 13 prepared for the band as an expression of high regard by the Texas 14 House of Representatives.
