1 WHEREAS, Alexis Jackson has been named the 2020 Child
2 Advocate of the Year by Child Advocates of Fort Bend; and

3 WHEREAS, Founded in 1991, CAFB is a nonprofit agency that
4 serves child victims of abuse and neglect by providing therapy and
5 mental health services in addition to case management and clinical
6 family advocacy; working in coordination with Court Appointed
7 Special Advocates (CASA) and the Children's Advocacy Center, the
8 agency has assisted nearly 19,000 children since its inception; and

9 WHEREAS, Alexis Jackson began volunteering with CASA in 2016,
10 and she has served children in the Infant and Toddler program as
11 well as the Nurturing Education and Social Triumphs (NEST) program,
12 which is focused on helping young people ages 6 to 13; this
13 dedicated volunteer was the first in the organization to join both
14 the Friends Council fundraising auxiliary group and the Volunteer
15 Council, where she helps to provide support and mentorship for new
16 volunteers; moreover, she is a lead member of the CAFB annual
17 Christmas Home Tour and Gala; and

18 WHEREAS, Alexis Jackson's dedication, compassion, and
19 commitment to the children of Fort Bend County have made a positive
20 and lasting difference in the lives of many area residents, and she
21 is indeed deserving of this notable accolade; now, therefore, be it
