1 WHEREAS, A life dedicated to the service of her country and 2 her community drew to a close with the death of retired U.S. Air 3 Force Colonel Patricia Ellen Frain on May 3, 2021, at the age of 75; 4 and

5 WHEREAS, Pat Frain was born in St. Louis, Missouri, on June 6 19, 1945, to Luke and Ann Frain; after graduating from Hillsboro 7 High School in Illinois in 1963, she earned a nursing degree from 8 St. Luke's Hospital School of Nursing in St. Louis; and

9 WHEREAS, Answering her nation's call to duty, Ms. Frain joined the U.S. Air Force in June 1970, and over the course of her 10 11 exemplary 22-year military career, she earned the Meritorious 12 Service Medal with two bronze oak leaf clusters, the Air Force Commendation Medal, the Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with one 13 14 bronze oak leaf cluster, the Air Force Organizational Excellence Award, and the National Defense Service Medal with one bronze star, 15 16 among many other awards; after retiring in August 1992 at the rank of colonel, she received the Legion of Merit, one of the highest 17 honors given to military personnel; and 18

WHEREAS, Ms. Frain continued to serve in civilian life as an inspiring mentor to many people, and she was the mayor of Sunrise Beach for 13 years, earning the respect of the community for her no-nonsense servant leadership, never asking anyone to do anything she wasn't willing to do herself; in retirement, she delighted in the time she spent sewing, quilting, and embroidering, and she also
