2 in Allen, has achieved great distinction by finishing in the top 100
3 contestants in the 2021 CyberStart America National Cyber
4 Scholarship Competition; and

5 WHEREAS, The CyberStart America initiative is an innovative
6 cybersecurity training program in which high school students
7 compete for scholarships and prizes; developed by the SANS
8 Institute, the initiative encourages the next generation to pursue
9 careers in the field; in the CyberStart online challenge, students

11 realistic problems and puzzles and to explore such topics as
