WHEREAS, Through his affiliation with the NAACP, Mr. Bledsoe 18 has been a staunch defender of civil rights; he handled cases involving allegations of discrimination against 19 the Texas Department of Public Safety, and he further lent his expertise to 20 21 the Austin Cedar Avenue case that led to widespread changes in how 22 instances of police brutality are addressed; the 23 settlement for that case was used to create a scholarship program for college-bound minority youth, and Mr. Bledsoe also went on to 24

- 2 establish a scholarship program for African American students
- 3 attending historically Black universities; and

- 5 received the Kelly Alexander State President of the Year Award, the
- 6 Juanita Jackson Mitchell Award for Legal Advocacy, and the Benjamin
- 7 Hooks Keeper of the Flame Award, and he was inducted into the
- 8 Houston Hall of Fame at Riverside General Hospital; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Over the course of his exemplary tenure with the
- 10 NAACP, Gary Bledsoe has done much to advance the causes of equality
- 11 and justice in his community, state, and nation, and it is a
- 12 pleasure to join his peers in recognizing him for his lifelong
- 13 commitment to these ideals; now, therefore, be it

- 15 Legislature hereby honor Gary Bledsoe for his contributions as
