## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, For three decades, Austin attorney Gary Bledsoe has
rendered exceptional service as president of the Texas NAACP; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Bledsoe earned his juris doctor degree from The University of Texas School of Law, where he was president of the 4 5 Class of 1976; his practice areas have included public interest, employment, and civil rights law, and in recognition of his legal 6 7 acumen, he received a coveted AV professional rating from Martindale-Hubbell; he has also been awarded Lawyer of the Year 8 9 honors from the Travis County Bar Association and several other 10 organizations; and

11 WHEREAS, This well-respected legal professional has long 12 championed the work of the NAACP, and he has held the office of 13 president of the Texas NAACP since being elected in 1991; he has 14 additionally served on the NAACP's national board since 2003, and 15 he currently chairs the organization's National Criminal Justice 16 Committee; and

WHEREAS, Through his affiliation with the NAACP, Mr. Bledsoe 17 18 has been a staunch defender of civil rights; he handled cases involving allegations of discrimination against 19 the Texas Department of Public Safety, and he further lent his expertise to 20 21 the Austin Cedar Avenue case that led to widespread changes in how instances of police brutality are addressed; the 22 landmark 23 settlement for that case was used to create a scholarship program for college-bound minority youth, and Mr. Bledsoe also went on to 24

1 successfully negotiate with the H-E-B supermarket chain to 2 establish a scholarship program for African American students 3 attending historically Black universities; and

9 WHEREAS, Over the course of his exemplary tenure with the 10 NAACP, Gary Bledsoe has done much to advance the causes of equality 11 and justice in his community, state, and nation, and it is a 12 pleasure to join his peers in recognizing him for his lifelong 13 commitment to these ideals; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas 15 Legislature hereby honor Gary Bledsoe for his contributions as 16 president of the Texas NAACP and extend to him sincere best wishes 17 for continued success; and, be it further

18 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 19 prepared for Mr. Bledsoe as an expression of high regard by the 20 Texas House of Representatives.
