1           WHEREAS, Brian Johnson was reelected as mayor of Kennedale in  
2 November 2020; and

3           WHEREAS, First elected in 2014, Mayor Johnson serves as the  
4 second vice president of Texas Municipal League Region 8, as chair  
5 of the Mayors' Council of Tarrant County, and as vice chair of the  
6 Southeast Tarrant Transportation Partnership; he is also immediate  
7 past chair of the Tarrant Regional Transportation Coalition  
8 executive board and a member of the boards of the Tarrant County  
9 Homeless Coalition and Tarrant County 9-1-1 District; moreover, he  
10 has contributed his time and expertise to several National League  
11 of Cities committees; and

12           WHEREAS, Mayor Johnson was appointed to the city council in  
13 2005, and he served as mayor pro tem from 2012 to 2014; for seven  
14 years, he was a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission, which  
15 he chaired from 2001 to 2005; he was also involved in the Imagine  
16 Kennedale 2015 planning committee that developed TownCenter Plaza;  
17 in 2009, he was named Community Representative of the Year by the  
18 Kennedale Area Chamber of Commerce; and

19           WHEREAS, The effective operation of government depends on the  
20 able and dedicated efforts of our public servants, and Brian  
21 Johnson may indeed take pride in his outstanding leadership in  
22 addressing the needs of the community; now, therefore, be it
