1 WHEREAS, The Lake Highlands High School football team put
2 together an outstanding 2020 season, claiming the District 7-6A
3 championship and advancing to the University Interscholastic
4 League playoffs; and

5 WHEREAS, For the first time in 25 years, the Wildcats
6 finished regular season competition undefeated, compiling 10 wins
7 without a loss; they closed out the regular schedule with a decisive
8 49-0 victory over Irving High School that was the 400th football
9 triumph in school history; and

10 WHEREAS, In the opening round of the postseason, the Wildcats
11 matched up against a talented team from South Grand Prairie High
12 School on December 11; the Lake Highlands players turned in a
13 valiant effort but ultimately fell short, ending the season with a
14 final record of 10 wins and one loss; and

15 WHEREAS, Over the course of the season, the Wildcats received
16 valuable contributions from each member of the roster; these
17 determined student-athletes were ably guided by head coach Lonnie
18 Jordan, who was named a finalist for the 2020 Landry Coach of the
19 Year award from the Greater Dallas-Fort Worth Fellowship of
20 Christian Athletes; the honor is presented to the high school coach
21 in North Texas who best exemplifies the values that defined
22 legendary Dallas Cowboys football coach Tom Landry, both on and off
23 the field; and

24 WHEREAS, With their notable accomplishments on the gridiron

1 during 2020, the members of the Wildcat football team have earned
2 the admiration of their fellow students and their many community
3 supporters, and they may indeed reflect with pride on a job well
4 done; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
6 Legislature hereby congratulate the Lake Highlands High School
7 football team on a successful 2020 season and commend Coach Lonnie
8 Walker on being named a finalist for the Landry Coach of the Year
9 award; and, be it further

11 prepared for the team as an expression of high regard by the Texas
12 House of Representatives.
