1           WHEREAS, The city of Waco lost a beloved resident with the  
2 passing of Robert Pearson on May 5, 2021, at the age of 76; and

3           WHEREAS, The son of Oneta Pearson, Robert Pearson was born in  
4 Waco on October 18, 1944, and he grew up with two siblings, Mary Jo  
5 and Cecil; he graduated from A. J. Moore High School and moved to  
6 Reno, Nevada, where his older brother had a job waiting for him in  
7 the restaurant at Harrah's Reno Hotel & Casino; when he turned 21,  
8 he was hired as a bartender; and

9           WHEREAS, Weary of the casino scene, Mr. Pearson lived in  
10 Houston for five years, and he returned to Waco in 1983; along the  
11 way, he found employment as a club manager and floor finisher, and  
12 he also worked in television production and at a hospital; and

13           WHEREAS, Mr. Pearson became a well-known figure in Waco after  
14 opening a shoeshine stand at the airport; wise, witty, and  
15 well-versed in many topics, he offered customers lively  
16 conversation while putting a "glow on their toe"; frequent flyers  
17 would stop for a chat on their way through the airport, and when he  
18 wasn't busy polishing, he helped travelers with their luggage,  
19 offered advice on where to dine, provided directions, or summoned  
20 an Uber; customers became friends, and when his lease ended after 14  
21 years, he got two offers of free locations; he set up his business  
22 at the Extraco Bank during the week and at Magnolia Market at the  
23 Silos on Saturdays; and

24           WHEREAS, Over the years, Robert Pearson brightened the days

1 of countless people, and although he is deeply missed, his warmth  
2 and kindness will remain a source of inspiration to all who were  
3 privileged to share in the richness of his life; now, therefore, be
