1 WHEREAS, The Dallas Urban Debate Alliance is a nonprofit

organization that is dedicated to providing Dallas ISD students

3 from all backgrounds with the opportunity to expand their

4 intellectual horizons by participating in debate; and

5 WHEREAS, The Dallas Urban Debate Alliance was formed in 2007,

6 at a time when few public high school students in Dallas had access

7 to competitive policy debate programming; with support from the

8 National Association for Urban Debate Leagues, several individuals

9 with debate experience were recruited to be part of the new

10 organization; over the years, the Dallas Urban Debate Alliance has

11 expanded to dozens of high schools and middle schools, where it

12 serves more than 1,000 students; and

WHEREAS, Through the program, participants learn to conduct

14 in-depth research and to prepare arguments on complex policy

15 topics, and they are able to put their skills to the test at

16 tournaments; in 2015, two Dallas Urban Debate Alliance teams

17 received national recognition by advancing to the octofinal and

18 semifinal rounds at the Urban Debate National Championship, an

19 event that was attended by over 50 teams from around the country;

22 some of the top coaches in the area, who in turn are provided with

23 supplies, continued curriculum support, and professional

24 development; those who excel in the program can earn scholarships

- 4 College; in addition, students enjoy many other benefits from

- 6 rates; studies have shown that student debaters also have higher
- 7 literacy scores and grade-point averages, and they perform better
- 8 on the reading and English sections of college readiness exams; and
