1 WHEREAS, Steve Porter concluded his dedicated service as a
2 member of the Sugar Land City Council in May 2021; and

3 WHEREAS, A city resident for more than four decades,
4 Mr. Porter represented District 1 on the council for eight years,
5 including a term as mayor pro tempore from 2016 to 2017; during his
6 exemplary tenure, he worked to make Sugar Land one of the safest
7 cities in the nation and helped guide the effort to invest nearly
8 \$70 million in drainage, mobility, parks, and infrastructure; in
9 addition, he championed continued investment in high-tech mobility
10 initiatives, spearheaded the establishment of the city's first
11 Ethics Review Board, and played a leading role in the creation of
12 the Smart Financial Centre and the Integrated Water Resource Plan;

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Porter holds a bachelor's degree in physics from
15 the University of Houston and a master's degree in business
16 administration from Houston Baptist University, and he is retired
17 from a career as an information technology manager with ExxonMobil
18 that spanned nearly 40 years; in all his endeavors, he benefits from
19 the love and support of Nancy, his wife of 42 years, as well as that
20 of his four sons, three daughters-in-law, and eight grandchildren;

23 representing the interests of their constituents, city council
