1 WHEREAS, The passing of admired inventor, entrepreneur, and 2 beef industry pioneer William Cline Pratt on October 21, 2020, at 3 the age of 77, brought a great loss to his family and friends; and WHEREAS, The son of Kenneth and Virginia Pratt, Bill Pratt 4 5 was born in San Antonio on November 5, 1942, and he grew up on a ranch in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, with two siblings, Hal and Kathleen; 6 7 he married the love of his life, the former Linda Brooks, and they became the proud parents of three sons, Bryan, who died in September 8 9 2020, and Fred and Glen; and WHEREAS, After earning his bachelor's degree in animal 10 11 science from Oklahoma State University, Mr. Pratt served in the 12 U.S. Army National Guard for seven years; he invented and patented a revolutionary system for measuring and delivering micro feed 13 14 ingredients to cattle, and in 1971, he and his wife founded Micro Chemical Incorporated in Amarillo; the company expanded into 15 16 ranching, packing, retailing, and other areas, and it became Micro Beef Technologies in 1999; by 2011, Mr. Pratt held nearly 90 17 patents in the U.S. and abroad, and his company had well over 200 18
